# Welcome to Club Waimea Squash 2011 Season



Welcome to Richmond's centre for squash; where we provide squash at all levels in a fun environment for the social and competitive player. Our busy club offers 4 glass backed courts, a social area and ample parking area. We host the Nelson Bays Squash Junior A Squad training weekly, we run the Waimea Autumn and Spring League competitions, and also host the Nelson Bays Junior Open every year. This year we are also hosts of the South Island Masters Games squash. Players of all levels of experience are welcome to join. Please read on to see information about membership, fees, Club activities and events.

## Where Are We?

We are part of Club Waimea, located in Lower Queen Street.

The Club Waimea entrance is opposite the Racecourse, Lower Queen Street. The squash courts are located in the building in the camping ground. Follow the road to the left of the parking area.

## How Do You Get In?

An electronic key tag is required to enter the squash complex. Swipe your key tag over the sensors to release the front door. Your key tag will also operate the lights. To operate the lights swipe your electronic key tag over the sensor for the court you wish to use (courts are numbered 1 to 4). This will give you one hour of playing time.

## Membership

Club memberships commence from the 1<sup>st</sup> of June each year. Membership renewals must be made by the 30<sup>th</sup> of June. Members who have not renewed by then will have their access tag disabled until membership is renewed.

\* Includes 2 adults (married/de-facto) and any dependent children aged under 19 all living in the same household.

^ Social membership is for leisure players who do not wish to play competitive squash. Country memberships are for players who are full members of another squash club.

From 1 October, pro-rata rates are available.

All memberships include a \$10 fee for an access key tag, so existing members subtract \$10 off the fees shown above.

All members must complete the "Application for Membership" form every year. This is a hard copy of member details and also their acknowledgement of the clubs rules and regulations. Member signature is required.

With a **full membership** you will be:

- Registered with Squash New Zealand as a graded player. This means you will be listed on the national grading list and can play competitive squash (such as Interclub, Tournaments and Super Champs). You will be eligible for Nelson Bays, Wellington and New Zealand teams, and are eligible to attend courses for officiating and coaching.
- A full member of the Club Waimea and can enjoy all their facilities (e.g. main restaurant, bar, pool and snooker tables).
- Entitled to attend social events and tournaments organised by Club Waimea Squash.

With a **social / country** membership you will be:

- A full member of Club Waimea and can enjoy all their facilities (e.g. main restaurant, bar, pool and snooker tables).
- Entitled to attend social events and tournaments organised by the squash club.

## Casual Court Hire

If you wish to play an existing member, casual court fees are \$5 per person, per hour. Please fill in a casual court fee ticket and place together with your \$5 into the interclub box (beside the booking sheet).

If you wish to hire a court (and are not playing an existing member) casual court hire is \$10. An access key tag can be obtained from Club Waimea (office 10am to 4pm, from the bar outside those hours). A \$10 deposit is also required and will be refunded on return of the key tag.

Loan tags can be provided to those wishing to trial the game for a short period before making a membership commitment.

## Grading List Registration

All **new members** to the club need to register with Squash New Zealand at [www.squash.org.nz/sit](http://www.squash.org.nz/sit)

- Go to the site and click REGISTER
- Fill in all the fields, then click SUBMIT
- A confirmation e-mail will then be sent to you with a link. Click on this link to confirm your registration.
- Once you have confirmed your registration, login.

- Your club will then need to accept you as a member of the club. If you wish to be a *graded player*, the club will also apply for a player code and grade for you. Once accepted you will be able to play interclub and graded tournaments. She will then contact you with your code and grade once accepted by Squash NZ.
